PURPOSE

The Open Door Bible Institute was established to train men and women for the work of the ministry. The Institute was designed to meet the needs of working people; those who have a desire to learn more about the Bible or to train for the ministry, without leaving their jobs to enroll in college full-time.

CLASS SCHEDULE

Our goal in class scheduling is to be flexible as well as accessible. Therefore, classes are scheduled around current church service times on Sundays and Thursdays. With this schedule we are able to offer a rotating calendar with four new classes available each year. Courses offered each term are at the instructors' discretion, but many other courses are offered through our correspondence program; check the list for available classes.

DEGREES AVAILABLE

ODBI offers four theological degrees. The Biblical Studies Degree typically takes two years to complete, and the Pastoral Degree (our Bachelor's Degree), depending on class scheduling and the student's flexibility, can be obtained in three to four years of study. Classes required for each diploma are listed below. A Master's and Doctorate Degrees are also obtainable, through extended study.

BIBLICAL STUDIES DEGREE

To receive the Degree in Biblical Studies the student must complete 36 credit hours; the following classes are required for graduation:

- * Genesis 1&2 (6 Credits)
 - Old Testament Survey 1&2 (6 Credits)
 - New Testament Survey 1&2 (6 Credits)
 - Acts 1&2 (6 Credits)
- * Romans 1&2 (6 Credits)
- * Bible Doctrine (3 Credits)

** These classes are available at any time convenient to the student, via correspondence.*

The remaining 3 credit hours may be achieved through any course of study offered through the Institute or by correspondence.

PASTORAL STUDIES DEGREE

To receive the Degree in Pastoral Studies the student must complete 96 credit hours; the following classes are required for graduation:

 - Old Testament Survey 1&2 (6 Credits)

New Testament Survey 1&2 (6 Credits)

Life of Christ 1&2 (6 Credits)

MASTER'S DEGREE IN BIBLICAL STUDIES

A Pastoral/Bachelor's Degree is prerequisite for study. Student must complete 36 credit hours and Master's thesis. *Pursuit of a Master's Degree requires a consult with an academic advisor.*

DOCTORATE OF MINISTRY

A Master's Degree is prerequisite for study. Student must complete 36 credit hours and Doctorate thesis. *Pursuit of a Doctorate requires a consult with an academic advisor.*

FINANCIAL POLICY

Institute tuition is \$30 per credit hour. (Classes are available free of charge for those wishing to audit and not receive credit.) We accept check, money order, cash or credit cards. A \$50 deposit is required before the semester begins. All tuition balances must be paid prior to final exams. No records, including grades, will be released if there is an outstanding balance on the student's account. Students are required to purchase their own textbooks, which are available through our Bookstore.
